#### *K-Art Projects USA, Booth 200*

*The African Spirit*, by artist and designer Andre Croteau, is a pop art-inspired metaphor for the cultural colonization of Africa. The overall impression is that of a colorful, pop art-inspired textile mural. It encompasses a symbolic mixing of European and African cultures, reflected through the integration of more elegant, typically European evening fabrics with the more traditional everyday pattern work worn by many African cultures. Texture and an overall sculptural rhythm round the work at the same time symbolizing the ebb and flow of the overall global cultural process, further reinforced by the overall pop-cultural inspiration of the work.
